

Siting Recommendations

- Unsheltered racks will not get used enough to be worth purchasing. (Racks can be used indoors in secure areas though)
- Site a Locker Cluster at Haze-Ruby McQuain Waterfront Park Would serve bus riders, bike commuters, students and park users Gives Bartlett House clients a safe place to leave bikes overnite
- Site a Bike Gard Cluster or Bike Tree in the downtown area Serves shoppers, students and commuters Possible sites include Courthouse, Forest Street, Parking Garages
- Survey retail, business and campus locations as to suitability for additional lockers and bike trees. These should be placed on the North side of buildings to provide shelter from sun and storms.

Additional Options

Use Vacant indoor space

City Hall has rooms, lockers and showers in the basement This could be a complete commuter facility (including laundry?)

Site individual lockers in spaces around downtown Rather than clustering all of the lockers in one location
