MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

With this Motion, PATH Allegheny Virginia Transmission Corporation ("PATH-VA") requests that the State Corporation Commission (the "Commission") grant an immediate suspension of the current procedural schedule in the above-captioned proceeding while PATH-VA's Motion to Withdraw its Application and Terminate Proceeding, filed separately and concurrently with this Motion, is being considered. All parties to this proceeding face a significant amount of work in the near term: the filing on December 31, 2009 of PATH-VA's rebuttal testimony and certain load flow studies requested by the Hearing Examiner, the discovery to be propounded by the parties as to that rebuttal testimony, and, of course, the lengthy hearing scheduled to begin on January 19, 2010. Because such work would become unnecessary if the Motion to Withdraw is granted, PATH-VA asks that the Hearing Examiner expeditiously grant a suspension of the current procedural schedule while the Motion to Withdraw is being considered.
