This is to advise you that the Department of Environmental Protection **issued** the above referenced application on August 10, 2011.

CORESCO, LLC provided a no practical alternative demonstration and compensatory mitigation plan that were reviewed and accepted by DEP personnel. Pending NPDES modification number 26 of NPDES WV1002619 will address compliance with any potential pollutants associated with the proposed activity. Groundwater monitoring sites are proposed in CORESCO's pending article 3 application (O200709) to ensure compliance with groundwater monitoring requirements. Rates of coal ash application will be reviewed within the pending article 3 application.

In accordance with West Virginia Code §47-5A-7.1, you may appeal this decision to the Department of Environmental Protection Cabinet Secretary within fifteen (15) days after receipt of this notification.
